Agenda packet #	Section name	What's included

3	Action	Nestor tract leveling	Action	2.7	<p>⊕ The Conservancy's recently-acquired (9.1.06) Nestor tract needs leveling. The Conservancy has typically had to engage in rice field leveling after a property has been acquired. Leveling is typically expensive, but is needed for efficient water use, uniform yields, weed management (herbicide use reduction) and other agronomic issues (water level adjustment for temperature management, etc.).</p> <p>The 233-acre Nestor tract (tract #20 on the Conservancy's Base Map) is an important component of the Conservancy's fulfillment of the 50 percent rice land use allocation required in the 2003 NBHCP. It provides giant garter snake support in an area known to have healthy populations. Therefore, keeping the Nestor tract viable is essential.</p> <p>The farming contractor on the site, Sopwith Farms, has agreed to conduct the pre-leveling land preparation costs such as chiseling, disking and landplaning at its expense. Doug Stanton has conducted the preliminary engineering on the tract. Stanton engineered the successful Elsie tract leveling project conducted last year.</p> <p>Staff recommends that the farming contractor on the Nestor tract, Sopwith Farms, be hired by the Conservancy on an hourly basis to conduct this work. Sopwith Farms has agreed to cap the charges at \$44,000.00. However, since this effort has a cost share arrangement (see tenant's land preparation cost discussion above), we expect the final amount of hours necessary to complete the job will result in less cost to the Conservancy. The Conservancy's 2008 Budget allocates \$45,000.00 for this project.</p>

Because so many resources (money, staff time) have been used to complete these projects, the tour will help familiarize Board members with the projects and their importance. The focus will be on land improvements (fencing, water control structures, channel dimensions, ponding, vegetation planting, site security, water supply sources, etc.). There will be no need for field attire since the tour is planned as a windshield tour.
