RE: Subsidence Monitoring in the Natomas Basin

Dear John,

The Natomas Mutual Water Company is participating in a groundwater conjunctive use program for the 2015 water season. Although we do not anticipate subsidence, we plan on monitoring the groundwater levels as part of responsible program participation. It is Natomas' hope to install 5 monitoring points. The monuments installed at the monitoring sites will consist of a concrete cylinder, 8" diameter by 3.5' long. The cylinders will be buried, and the top of the monument will be flush with the ground. Natomas would like to locate 3 monuments at TNBC's well sites, with the following terms:

- Monuments to be installed at Bennett North, Silva, and Natomas Farms.
- Natomas will indemnify TNBC for installation and monitoring of the monuments.
- Natomas will request approval from TNBC for the monument location, prior to installation.
- Natomas will replace or repair monuments, at Natomas' cost, if damaged by TNBC staff or contractors.
- Natomas will monitor the monuments twice annually, in the spring and fall.

Please advise if TNBC finds this acceptable; Feel free to contact me if you have any questions or concerns.
