<u>Review the audited financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2020.</u> Prior to the auditor's report, Burns informed the committee of a number they would be seeing in the audit titled Unearned Mitigation Land Credits. Since this was new, she wanted to introduce the matter to the committee and explain its purpose. This number represents the accounting treatment of those acres the Conservancy owns, via land dedication, but for which mitigation has not yet occurred.

Peggy Vande Vooren with Gilbert Associates, Inc. (Gilbert) reviewed with the committee the scope and the results of the Conservancy's audited financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2020. Gilbert issued an unqualified (clean) opinion on the Conservancy's 2020 financial statements and internal control over financial reporting. No management letter was issued.
